Southeast Area Businesses are Growing and Enjoying the Spotlight!

Twenty-one Southeast Michigan area companies will be recognized on April 28th when they receive the 2011 Michigan 50 Companies to Watch Award at the seventh annual Michigan Celebrates Small Business event in Lansing.

More music, less work is Livio Radio's mantra. A rising star in the consumer electronics arena and a 2011 Michigan 50 Companies to Watch award recipient. The company makes electronic devices that enable people to access Internet radio without a computer or phone.

Founder Jake Sigal, a third-generation entrepreneur, launched the company in 2008 as Myine Electronics with a focus on designing products that operate quickly without complicated menus. In 2010, the company rebranded in as Livio (a merger of the words "living room" and "radio").

"Our growth is a result of the wave of digital music complementing traditional broadcast and satellite radio," commented Jake. "Our style of creating products to play 'more music with less work' helped us stay ahead of this curve. It's an honor to be recognized for doing things differently."

Livio Radio is one of numerous companies that have been recognized as a Michigan 50 Company to Watch in the Southeast area in the past years.

Standard Component Inc. (SCI) received the Michigan 50 Companies to Watch award in 2010. Last year the company experienced a 101% growth in revenue and projects a 20% increase in 2011. In addition, SCI expects to increase the number of hires by 15.1% in the coming year.

Chief Executive Officer, James Wilkins attributes a portion of their growth to receiving the award. "By being named one of the Michigan 50, SCI received some very valuable publicity, commented James. We also use it as a marketing tool to demonstrate that we are head and shoulders above our competitors."
